Day 1

<p>Purchase a domain name. This is the URL people will go to in order to find your site (example: google.com). Siteground, GoDaddy, Bluehost.</p>	
<p>Purchase web hosting. The place you'll upload your website files so they can be accessed on the internet. Siteground, GoDaddy, Bluehost, WPEngine, Flywheel.</p>	
<p>Upload and install WordPress. Use instructions on WordPress.org OR most web hosts will do this for you!</p>	



Day 2

<p>Get to know WordPress. Posts, pages, categories, themes and plugins. Watch the WordPress Basic course in the Customer Center.</p>	
<p>Configure WordPress. Under Settings > General, configure your Site Title, Tagline and Timezone. Under Permalinks, set to "Post Name".</p>	
<p>Menus and widgets. Under Appearance > Menus, create your first menu and add items. Under Appearance > Widgets, add a widget to a sidebar.</p>	



Day 3

<p>Install Plugins. Go to Plugins > Add New. MonsterInsights, Custom CSS and JS, Elementor, Wordfence, WP Super Cache</p>	
<p>Install Theme. Under Appearance > Themes. OceanWP, Hello, Astra.</p>	
<p>Install and Configure WishList Member. Plugins > Add New. Click "Upload Plugin" and find the WishList Member .zip file on your computer. Enter your license key and run the Getting Started Wizard.</p>	



Day 4

<p>Configure Payment Provider. Go to WishList Member > Setup > Integrations. Pick your Payment Provider and follow instructions.</p>	
<p>Configure Email Provider. Go to WishList Member > Setup > Integrations. Click on the Email Provider tab, pick your Email Provider and follow instructions.</p>	
<p>Optionally Configure Third-Party Services. Zapier, BuddyBoss, LearnDash, Slack, WebHooks, etc.</p>	



Day 5

<p>Create a Dashboard Page. Pages > Add New > Edit With Elementor and use the built-in templates.</p>	
<p>Create a Sales Page. Pages > Add New > Edit With Elementor. Above the fold, features, pricing, buy now button, guarantee.</p>	
<p>Create Admin Pages. Non-Members Error page, Membership Cancelled page and After Registration page.</p>
